



CONDUCTOR RAIL CLEANING DEVICE

ARG 14 DS





The cleaning device Model ARG 14 DS cleans conductor rails with a conductor spacing of 14 mm (U10) automatically and preventive from dust deposits.

The cleaning device consists of a side channel blower (230/400 V) with filter housing and a suction head equipped according to the number of poles/conductors. It is to be mounted to the overhead monorail system carrier (by others).

Cleaning elements are installed to collectors instead of carbon brushes.





Cleaning device ARG 14 DS for U10 conductor rails









The compact conductor rail cleaners are available for the same number of conductors as the compact current collectors. They have cleaning elements instead of carbon brushes.

They are installed like current collectors and clean the rail through the integrated suction nozzle. Cleaning elements must **not** be used for current collection for safety reasons.



Compact rail cleaners

As is mandatory for overhead monorail systems, pole no. 4 has a PE connection.

Safety instructions:

- Caution when handling live parts!
 Carbon dust is conductive and may cause short circuits!
- On heavily soiled systems, the filter bag (inside the filter housing) needs to be replaced at short intervals!
- > Do not inhale carbon dust!
- Filter bags may not be shaken out but must be disposed!
